- 1. Personal information and educational record form (with appropriate academic transcript attached).
- 2. Honors, extracurricular and non-school/work and church activities sheet.
- 3. Accomplishment you are most proud of and the essay sheet.
- 4. Recommendation from Employer, Adult Mentor or Teacher/Professor.
- 5. Recommendation from Pastor/Campus Ministry.
- 6. Scholarship remittance information.

Active Peace Lutheran Church members are given priority consideration, although other students are also seriously considered.

### 2024-2025 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The purpose of the Peace Scholarship Fund is to encourage one or more students to pursue a college education, to better enable them to share Christ, and to encourage students seeking a college or technical degree with preference being given to those attending a Lutheran institution.

## Students applying for one of these scholarships must meet <u>all</u> of the following requirements:

- 1. Be an active member of Peace Lutheran Church.
- 2. Be a high school graduate with a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
- 3. College students will have a grade point average of 3.0.
- 4. Be accepted to a secondary school for the upcoming school year, as a full-time student carrying a minimum of 12 credits.
- 5. Complete and submit the enclosed application; secure the requested recommendations; attach the most recent high school or college transcript to your Scholarship Application.

### Scholarships will be awarded according to the following priority:

- 1. The first priority will be given to anyone preparing for a church vocation.
- 2. The second priority will be given to anyone attending a Lutheran College.
- 3. The third priority will be given to those attending colleges elsewhere.

The recipients of these scholarships will be notified by mail on or before the second Friday of May.

Scholarship recipients will be presented with their certificates of award in person at the 9:00 a.m. church service the first Sunday of June.

Please read and follow instructions carefully. It is essential that all forms, transcripts and recommendations be received by 12:00 p.m. on the third Friday of April. *This deadline is strictly observed!* Applications can be sent to the Church office at 240 W. 9<sup>th</sup> Ave., Oshkosh, WI 54902, or submitted via email to office@peaceoshkosh.org.

Please note that scholarship applicants are responsible to check whether all required documents have been received at the church office. The Church Office will not notify applicants of missing documents. A checklist of all the necessary documents is enclosed to help you track them.
