THOUGHTS FROM PASTOR BRAD

¹ How very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in unity! ² It is like the precious oil on the head, running down upon the beard, on the beard of Aaron, running down over the collar of his robes. ³ It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion. For there the Lord ordained his blessing, life forevermore. - PSALM 133

As you read this we have wrapped up the annual meeting and set our vision for what 2020 might look like at Peace. On the horizon are big projects like talking about how to best handle a roof that needs to be replaced, how to take care of our new gym floor, making plans to welcome in the Boys and Girls Club of Oshkosh to use our facility over the summer and that is only the beginning. Then you think about ongoing items like the VP's who continue to do wonderful work to benefit others, the Lunch Bunch that gathers 15-20 people each month together for a meal and lively conversation, the Family Ties group and the newly forming "youth group" for kids at heart, add in education taking place through Sunday School, Confirmation and the amazing work being done by our leadership and ministry teams -Peace Lutheran is a busy place!

Add to that - did you know that we have, on average, 165 people in worship each week between three services? According to our records, there are roughly 360 people who are "active" members of Peace and well over 900 people who claim Peace Lutheran as their church home. We are a big community of believers and we are all called to live together in unity the best that we can.

To live in unity means we need to find compromises along the way. We need to find ways to honor people's ideas, opinions and understandings while still acknowledging that not all of it is possible. Which can

be frustrating because often we think we know what's best but, in reality, we know what's best for ourselves and maybe a small group of people but not necessarily for the entire group. That's why it's important to me as a leader to listen to the voices of others as I make decisions. I think that's a lesson that Jesus often teaches us in the Gospels; we are to listen to others and then respond with grace and love. Which means that sometimes our desires aren't fully met or realized in the way we wish they were.

How can we best live in the community that has been gathered together by God? I believe it's by being active in the areas that excite us, supporting the areas that excite others and striving to find God at work in the midst of all things.

Most of all, I want you to know that I give thanks to God every day that I have been called to serve among you at Peace. I am humbled to see the many different ways that God is active and is stirring up new ideas among us while honoring the traditions that have carried us for almost 160 years.

May we do our best to live out this idea: *How very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in unity!* - Psalm 133:1

SUNDAY SCHOOL

2020 is off to a great start, and we are in full swing with Epiphany. Kids are busy learning all about John the Baptist and Jesus. We are looking forward to Lent at the end of the month as a time for reflection on Christ's journey to the cross.

For anyone thinking about or wondering what it is we do each week, here is a brief synopsis of what a typical week looks like during the education hour. Each Spark Lectionary lesson follows a four-part sequence:

1. **Gather** - We begin the morning by gathering together and trying a warm-up activity, prayer and songs to praise Him with. Currently we are working on two songs we will share with the congregations during each service on the 9th. We are so excited to share and hope you will enjoy our hard work.

After our large group opening we separate into our classrooms. Broken down by age. There is a Pre-K/K class, a first and second class, a third and fourth grade class and finally a 5th grade class.

2. **Open the Bible** - The Sparks Bible is used in the classroom to read the same Gospel lesson that is shared in church for the week. Age appropriate Bibles help break down the story and engage each learned.
3. **Activate Faith** - Get moving and become engaged in the story they just read by using their leaflets. We put into practice what we have read in the Bible and connect it to our everyday lives
4. **Send** - Finish with a closing activity and prayer. Each student is sent with an activity sheet and a family pamphlet with further readings, prayers and discussion points to use throughout the week.

If you have any questions about Sunday School, know a child who is interested in joining, or would simply like to stop in and observe, please do not hesitate to reach out. We are happy to share how we are learning and what a Spark's Lectionary Sunday School looks like. In addition, we are always looking for a few more volunteers to help teach. 


How do I pay?

You can set up a PrestoPay account in your [shopwithscrip](http://shopwithscrip.com) account and pay online with a \$0.15 transaction fee, or you can pay by cash or check made out to "Peace Lutheran Church" All payments must be received by noon on every other Monday to be included in the order. Orders are placed every other week and delivered to church by Friday on the week of the order.

How do I get my order?

All physical cards are picked up from a volunteer located in the narthex before or after most services OR available in the office. On-hand orders are ready for immediate pick-up.




