2022-2023 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The purpose of the Peace Scholarship Fund is to encourage one or more students to pursue a college education, to better enable them to share Christ, and to encourage students seeking a college or technical degree with preference being given to those attending a Lutheran institution.

Students applying for one of these scholarships must meet ***all*** of the following requirements:

1. Be a person of Christian faith and practice, and an active member of the Lutheran Church, with members of Peace given primary consideration.
2. Be a high school graduate with a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
3. College students will have a grade point average of 3.0.
4. Be a 2022-2023 full-time student carrying a minimum of 12 credits.
5. Complete and submit the enclosed application; secure the requested recommendations; attach the most recent high school or college transcript to your Scholarship Application.

Scholarships will be awarded according to the following priority:

1. The first priority will be given to anyone preparing for a church vocation.
2. The second priority will be given to anyone attending a Lutheran College.
3. The third priority will be given to those attending colleges elsewhere.

The winners of these scholarships will be notified by mail on or before May 20, 2022.

We are hopeful to continue the tradition of presenting scholarship recipients with their certificates of award in person at the 9:00 a.m. church service on June 5, 2022. While we have put protocols in place to ensure the good health of our members, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we recognize not all recipients will be comfortable receiving their certificate of award in-person and we will make other arrangements.

Please read and follow instructions carefully. **It is essential that all forms, transcripts and recommendations be received by 1:00 p.m. on April 18, 2022. This deadline is strictly observed!** Applications can be sent to the Church office at 240 W. 9th Ave., Oshkosh, WI 54902, or submitted via e-mail to office@peaceoshkosh.org.

Please note that scholarship applicants are responsible to check whether all required documents have been received at the church office. The Church Office will not notify applicants of missing documents. A checklist of all the necessary documents is enclosed to help you track them.
